Those families who meet our criteria, who want to participate in this Registration Assistance Program, will share equally per student in the amount of monies dedicated to this program. For example, 10 students sharing \$1,000, each student would receive \$100 in registration assistance. The more successful our fundraising efforts for the program, the more money will be allocated per student.
