

SCRIP PROFIT GUIDELINES FOR 2016-2017

The scrip program continues this year with the emphasis on profit to the school by way of purchases by families, and is just another way to help keep your tuition costs down.

Each single child family is required to generate \$210.00 in scrip profit; families with two or more children are required to generate \$235.00 in profit during the year starting May 1, 2017 through April 30, 2018. At the end of April 2018 any outstanding balance will be billed prior to acceptance of registration for the following year. You may opt out of the scrip program by paying (\$210.00 for one child, \$235.00 for two or more children) in full by August 19th **OR** \$21.00/\$23.50 a month/10 months beginning August 2017 and ending May 2018 **OR** \$17.50/\$19.58 a month/12 months beginning June 2017 and ending May 2018 (to be drawn on an ACH account).

HOW IT WORKS: The school purchases scrip at a discount from the merchant or through a Scrip Center. Each merchant determines the percentage to be donated. This can change at the discretion of the merchant throughout the year.

- Scrip may be purchased in the school office during school hours or when the office is open.
- You may also order and pay for scrip on the website, www.glscrip.com after setting up an account with Great Lakes Scrip. Scrip orders are delivered to the school office for pickup. You can print off your orders for some vendors. Check the website

The scrip order form will show the percentage of merchant donation along with the denominations that are available. We will make every attempt to keep those merchants on the Fast Track Order form available at all times. Check with the school office to see what they keep on hand on a regular basis. The office has the complete list of available merchants/percentages, or you can check for yourself at www.glscrip.com.

Orders will be placed on the Fridays of each month to keep shipping costs to a minimum. The turnaround delivery is usually 2-3 working days.

Check on the eScrip website to see which cards/vendors are affected. Your cards must be registered with E-Scrip (www.escrip.com, St. Patrick's School #137683576).
