Dear Parents,

Happy Friday! I hope that you enjoy a wonderful weekend of beautiful weather with your families. With the Easter vacation approaching it is important to remind you of the diocesan policy regarding travel. Here is the new verbiage of the diocese's amended policy.

Travel:

- a. Neither California nor the CDC has updated its guidance to make any changes for those who are fully vaccinated.
- b. Currently, under both the California Department of Public Health and CDC, it is recommended that travelers quarantine for 10 day after returning to the state. We are only recommending people to quarantine, but it's not a requirement.
- c. The Diocese has decided to discontinue its stricter restrictions which means that only the governmental recommendations will be in effect.

Please note that we will contact you if this policy changes again before Easter break, but as of today this is what is currently required.

Thanks to our teachers and students for the virtual Open House & Art/Science Fair. While our format was different it was wonderful to see students share their progress this year and to give parents a glimpse into all that they have accomplished – I am certainly a proud principal!

What you can expect from school if your child is sent home with a COVID symptom or you keep them home with a symptom of COVID:

1. You will receive a call to pick up your child from school due to COVID symptoms. If you are keeping child home, call office by 9AM and state reason for absence.
2. You will be sent an email or given a packet outlining your next steps in regard to testing and symptoms. Please note that if you decide not to test you must remain out of school for at least 10 days from start of symptoms
3. School office will notify classroom teacher of absence and need for distance learning. Classroom teacher or Distance Learning Coordinator will contact you on next steps to connect to Independent Study/Distance Learning Program.
4. Kendra Brownlee, registrar, will be contact person in regard to date to return to school
