EMERGENCY CARE PACKETS

(ALL GRADES)

Parents are asked to provide for each of their children a pack with the following items to be available in the event of an emergency: A large Ziplock bag, with name and grade of student clearly marked. Contents of the bag should include:

- Change of underwear & Toothbrush/paste
- Mylar emergency blanket for warmth
- Two granola bars
- Small pack moisturized towels
- Extra pair of glasses (if necessary) & necessary prescription medication with directions
- Two “puncture proof” containers of fruit juice
- Paperback book and/or small games
- ‘Comfort’ letter to child/ren from parent(s)/guardian(s) in case we are kept at school for a day or two.

These packs will be kept in the classrooms (medication will be kept in the office) until the last day of school, when they will be returned to the child.

KINDERGARTEN

Consumable supplies, please do not label:

- 1 **Primary** Composition Book with **space for a picture** at the top of each page
- 3 Black Sharpie Permanent Markers
- 1 bottle of 4 ounce Elmer’s white school glue
- 3 packs Crayola Twistables colored pencils
- 5 Elmer’s glue sticks, **large size** (about 1 ounce)
- 3 sets Crayola Twistables crayons, **10 count only**, classic colors
- 1 pair of 5” blunt scissors with metal blades and plastic handles
- 1 pink eraser
- 1 box of sidewalk chalk
- ‘Kindermat’ nap mat, **19” x 45” x 5/8”** available at Target/Walmart in late summer or on the internet. **Please send this size or smaller mat only with no covers or pillows.**

Please do not include any Kleenex, paper towels or wipes in the box as I cannot store these for the whole class for the year. I ask that they bring these items on their child’s birthday month only.

GRADE 1

Each student needs a backpack, water bottle and lunchbox. Most supplies will be pooled so please do not write your child's name on them. Keep in mind that objects can be a learning distraction. For this reason, we do not allow mechanical pencils, pens, fancy pencil boxes, toys, etc. in class.

- 1 Box Ziplock sandwich size bags
- 1 large soft pack container of disinfectant wipes
- 1 pump bottle hand soap (ex: Soft Soap)
- 1 set of watercolors, 8 color only
- 1 set colored pastels
- 1 box colored chalk
- 2 Play-Doh, 4 oz. cans any color
- 4 folders, with pockets, labeled with name (red, blue, yellow, green)
- 2 boxes (12 per box) of Ticonderoga Beginners yellow #2 pencils
- Fat highlighters: 2 each yellow, pink, green, blue, orange
- 1 red pen
- 2 boxes Crayons (24), (NO SMELLY CRAYONS)
- 2 packs of fat colored markers, (NO SMELLY MARKERS)
- 1 pack thin colored markers
- 2 boxes of colored pencils
- *Sharpie* markers black and assorted multi colors, your choice, for a total of 5 or 6
- 1 pack fat Dry Erase markers, multi colored
- 1 pack thin dry erase markers, multi colored
- Plastic pencil box (8.5x5.5x2.5) labeled with name (No fancy boxes- they are a learning distraction)
- 1 pair of blunt scissors with metal blade, child size, labeled with name
- 1 roll of scotch tape

- 6 - 8 Glue sticks
- 1 Elmer's School Glue, 4 oz.
- 2 Mead Primary Journal Creative Story Tablet, Grades K-2, Kindergarten 2nd Grade Workbook (09554) Available on Amazon.
- 5 large GUM (not rubber) erasers
- 1 pack- School Smart Zaner-Bloser Paper, ½ inch ruled, 8x10 ½ inch. Available on Amazon (You will want to have a pack of paper for home too for homework.)

GRADE 2

- 1 box of tissue
- 4 Sharpie permanent markers (black)
- 4 dry erase markers (any color)
- 1 pack of post it notes (just one pack... any color)
- 1 **small** eraser for dry erase board
- 3 dozen #2 pencils
- 2 packages of pencil top erasers
- 4 highlighter markers, any color
- 6 0.77 size glue sticks or 20 0.24 size glue sticks (whichever is easier to find)
- 10 manila file folders
- 2 containers of anti-bacterial wipes (for cleaning desktops)
- 1 set of fine tip markers for writing (these will be collected for general use)
- 1 box of crayons (for personal use so can be put in pencil box)
- 1 set of broad tip markers for coloring (markers and crayons may need to be replenished after the first semester...they can be put in the pencil box as they are for personal use)
- 4 **PLAIN PLASTIC pocket** folders (like Pee-Chee **but plastic**). We will label these the first week of school with permanent markers so it is important that the folders are **without** decoration.
- 1 primary composition book with lines only (no space for a picture needed)
- 5 spiral bound notebooks with **70 sheets MINIMUM (wide or college rule...whatever you can find)**
- 1 pair of **blunt** tip scissors, metal blade, child size
- 1 pencil case big enough for pencils, crayons and markers. **Plastic boxes work best. PLEASE LABEL THIS BOX.**
- Water bottle **with a sport top or straw type lid**

*All consumable supplies (glue, tape, erasers, tissue, sharpies) are for general use, **please do not label***

GRADE 3

- Library card
- headphones ***with a microphone*** (usb)
- Computer mouse
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 package of 3x5 index cards (***lined on one side***)
- 1 Pack of college ruled filler paper
- 1 1" binder for all subjects and dividers (1 set)
- 2 3 Subject spiral bound notebooks (The Mead 5-star, college ruled 8.5x11) or the like.
A piece of binder paper needs to fit on the page without hanging over.
- 1 composition notebook (9 ¾ X 7 ½), with ruled paper
- 3 ***plastic*** 2 pocket folders
- 1 Plastic zip pencil case for crayons and markers
- 2 dozen #2 ***Ticonderoga brand*** pencils
- 1 packages of pencil top erasers
- 1 package of Crayola Twistables colored pencils
- 1 pack of markers (example: Crayola 10 pack)
- 1 pack of white board markers (Black)
- 3 fine point sharpie pens (black)
- 3 ultra-fine point pens (black)
- 1 pair scissors (child-size)
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 highlighters different colors
- 1 package of cleaning wipes
- No pencil boxes
- Label sweatshirts please

Grade 4

- 1 to 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 pack of markers (example: Crayola 10 pack)

- 1 box of crayons and/or colored pencils
- 1 dozen #2 Pencils (Ticonderoga brand~ pre-sharpened)
- 1 package of pencil top erasers
- 5 glue sticks
- 1 1" binder for all subject
- 8 dividers for the binder (1 set)
- 2 Composition notebooks, 9 3/4 x 7 1/2 with ruled paper
- 1 **PLASTIC** pocket folder, pee chee style, no brads, plain (no decorations)...this will be used as a "Graded Work Folder"
- 1 college-ruled spiral notebook, 150 pages
- 2 college-ruled spiral notebooks, 70 pages each
- 2 red ballpoint pens for correcting
- 1 pencil box, about 8 3/8 x 5 5/8 inches
- 1 pair of scissors, child size
- 5 fine-point Sharpie pens, black
- 3 Ultra fine-point Sharpie pens, black
- 3 dry-erase markers, any color
- 4 highlighter pens
- Small handheld manual pencil sharpener

GRADE 5

Please **label** the following items with the student's full name (first and last):

- 1 backpack (needs to have the ability to be hung up on a hook by the student)
- 1 one and a half inch 3 ring binder
- 1 three ring zippered pencil pouch (to be kept in the binder)
- 2 plastic two pocket folders
 - Unfinished Work Folder
 - Graded Assignment Folder
- 4 college ruled, three subject spiral notebooks
 - Math (We will use all 3 sections!)
 - Novel Study/Vocabulary/Comprehension Skills
 - Writing/Grammar/Word Study
 - Religion/Science/Social Studies
- 1 composition notebook
 - Spanish
- 1 box of markers (Crayola brand is preferred)

- 1 box of colored pencils or crayons (Crayola brand is preferred)
- 1 pair of adult sized scissors

Please keep the following supplies unlabeled:

(students will keep some of these supplies at their desk and the extra supplies will be given out throughout the school year)

- 1 pack of 8 divider tabs (all 8 will be used in the one inch binder)
- 1 packet of lined paper (college ruled)
- 1 packet of computer/printer paper (8.5 x 11)
- 1 box of Ticonderoga pencils (pre sharpened preferred)
- 1 pack of dry erase markers (thin and black)
- 4 handheld plastic pencil sharpeners (all need to have a connected catch for pencil shavings)
- 5 highlighters (at least 2 different colors)
- 5 pink erasers
- 5 glue sticks
- 4 packages of Post-it notes (for exit tickets and for marking texts)
- 2 rolls of adhesive tape
- 2 black sharpies
- **2 boxes of Kleenex**
- **2 containers of disinfectant wipes**

GRADES 6; JR. HIGH 7 & 8

To be collected on the first day of school:

- Two box of Kleenex
- Clorox Wipes (x2)
- 5 Three subject spiral bound notebooks (The Mead 5-star, college ruled 8.5x11, notebooks held up really well this past year, or Costco) Please do not decorate the front, prior to school.
- 2 package of glue sticks and will need to be replenished after Christmas break
- Two dozen No. 2 pencils with erasers for Math class
- Eraser tops for pencils
- Erasers

- One packages of college ruled notebook paper and one package of graph paper for Math class
- 2 folders
- 1 package dry erase markers, no bright colors
- 1 ream of computer paper
- 1 ream of Cardstock paper
- Emergency pack to be turned in by end of first week of school

The following items need to be available to your student at all times throughout the school year. Usually by Christmas break supplies need to be re-evaluated and replenished.

- 1 pocket folder, marked for homework
- 2 stretchy book covers, JUMBO or one size fits all.
- Four (4) highlighters – various colors
- 3 White-out tape, NO LIQUID WHITE OUT!
- 5-10 blue or black ballpoint pens, avoid gel pens
- 5-10 red ballpoint pens
- 1 pair of adult-sized scissors, marked with name
- One package thin-tipped markers (8-12 colors) or one package of multi-colored flare pens
- One package of colored pencils
- Two permanent markers (Sharpies); @ least ONE black fine-tipped
- One (1) packages of 3-1/2 x 5" index cards – 100 each
- Post it notes
- Zip style pencil case, clearly marked with student's name, to travel with student to EVERY CLASS!
- 1 set of earbuds w/headphone jack
- One ruler
- One 1 ½ inch binder, preferably plastic
- One package of binder tab dividers
- One package of graph paper
