EMERGENCY CARE PACKETS

(ALL GRADES)

Parents are asked to provide for each of their children a pack with the following items to be available in the event of an emergency: A large Ziplock bag, with name and grade of student clearly marked. Contents of the bag should include:

- Change of underwear & Toothbrush/paste
- Mylar emergency blanket for warmth
- Two granola bars
- Small pack moisturized towels
- Extra pair of glasses (if necessary) & necessary prescription medication with directions
- Two “puncture proof” containers of fruit juice
- Paperback book and/or small games
- ‘Comfort’ letter to child/ren from parent(s)/guardian(s) in case we are kept at school for a day or two.

These packs will be kept in the classrooms (medication will be kept in the office) until the last day of school, when they will be returned to the child.

KINDERGARTEN

Consumable supplies, please do not label:

- 1 **Primary** Composition Book with **space for a picture** at the top of each page

- 1 set of watercolors, 8 color only

- 3 Play-Doh, 4 oz. cans any color
- 1 green folder
- 2 sharpened lead pencils, regular
- 1 fat, orange highlighter
- 3 boxes Twistables crayons, 10 count
- 1 pack of thick colored markers,
- 2 boxes of Twistables colored pencils, 18 count
- 2 *Sharpie* markers black
- 1 pack thick Dry Erase markers, 4 count
- 1 Dry Erase Eraser, small
- 1 Plastic pencil box (8.5x5.5x2.5) labeled with name (No fancy boxes- they are a learning distraction)
- 1 pair of blunt scissors with metal blade, child size, labeled with name
- 1 roll of scotch tape
- 6 small glue sticks
- 1 Primary Journal with room for picture
- 1 large GUM (not rubber) eraser

Please send the following supplies during the month of your child’s birthday. (Please do not order in supply box) All summer birthdays send these supplies on the first day of school:

- 1 box of Kleenex tissues

GRADE 2

General Use

- 1 box of tissue
- 4 dry erase markers (any color)
- 1 pack of post it notes (just one pack... any color)
- 1 eraser for dry erase board
- 3 dozen #2 pencils
- 2 packages of pencil top erasers
- 4 highlighter markers, any color

- 4 0.77 size glue sticks or 10 0.24 size glue sticks (whichever is easier to find)
- 5 manila file folders
- 2 packages of anti-bacterial wipes (for cleaning desktops)
- 1 set of fine tip markers (Crayola fine tip or Flair pens) for writing (these will be collected for general use)
- 2 rolls of scotch tape **without** the plastic dispenser

Personal Use

- 1 24 count box of crayons (for personal use so can be put in pencil box)
- 1 set of broad tip markers for coloring (markers and crayons may need to be replenished after the first semester...they can be put in the pencil box as they are for personal use)
- 3 **PLAIN PLASTIC** pocket folders (like Pee-Chee **but plastic**). We will label these the first week of school with permanent markers so it is important that the folders are **without** decoration.
- 1 primary composition book with lines only (no space for a picture needed)
- 4 spiral bound plain covered notebooks with **70 sheets MINIMUM** (wide or college rule...whatever you can find)
- 1 pair of **student scissors (metal, blunt tip)**
- 1 pencil case big enough for pencils, crayons and markers. **Plastic boxes work best. PLEASE LABEL THIS BOX.**
- Water bottle **with a sport top or straw type lid**

- 1 composition notebook (9 ¼ X 7 ½), with ruled paper
- 3 **plastic** 2 pocket folders
- 1 Plastic zip pencil case for crayons and markers
- 2 dozen #2 **Ticonderoga brand** pencils
- 1 packages of pencil top erasers
- 1 package of Crayola Twistables colored pencils
- 1 pack of markers (example: Crayola 10 pack)
- 2 packs of white board markers (Black)
- 3 fine point sharpie pens (black)
- 3 ultra-fine point sharpie pens (black)

- 2 dozen #2 Pencils (Ticonderoga brand~ pre-sharpened)
- 1 package of pencil top erasers
- 5 glue sticks
- 1 1" binder for all subject
- 8 dividers for the binder (1 set)
- 2 Composition notebooks, 9 3/4 x 7 1/2 with ruled paper
- 1 **PLASTIC** pocket folder, pee chee style, no brads, plain (no decorations)...this will be used as a "Graded Work Folder"
- 1 college-ruled spiral notebook, 150 pages
- 2 college-ruled spiral notebooks, 70 pages each
- 1 package of 3x5 index cards (**lined on one side**)
- 2 red ballpoint pens for correcting
- 1 pencil box, about 8 3/8 x 5 5/8 inches

 - Divider Labels: 1. Procedures, 2. Ongoing Projects, 3. ELA, 4.Math, 5. Religion, 6.Science, 7. Social Studies, 8. Extra Paper
- 1 three ring zippered pencil pouch (set up inside the binder)
- 2 plastic two pocket folders
 - Label: Unfinished Work Folder
 - Label: Graded Assignment Folder
- 2 college ruled, three subject spiral notebooks
 - Label: Math (We will use all 3 sections!)
 - Label: Religion/Science/Social Studies
- 1 college ruled, two subject notebook
 - Label: ELA/Writing
- 1 composition notebook
 - Label: Spanish
- 1 box of markers (Crayola brand is preferred)
- 1 box of colored pencils or crayons (Crayola brand is preferred)
- 1 pair of adult sized scissors

Please **keep** the following supplies **unlabeled**:

Students will keep some of these supplies in their cubbies or at their desk. Any extra supplies will be available for students when needed throughout the school year.

GRADES 6; JR. HIGH 7 & 8

To be collected on the first day of school:

- Three boxes of Kleenex
- Clorox Wipes (x2)
- 5 Three subject spiral bound notebooks (The Mead 5-star, college ruled 8.5x11, notebooks held up really well this past year, or Costco) Please do not decorate the front, prior to school.
- 4 packages of glue sticks
- 48 No. 2 pencils with erasers
- 2 packages eraser tops for pencils
- 4 bi.g Erasers (pink or white)
- One packages of college ruled notebook paper and one package of graph paper for Math class
- 2 folders (w/ 3 prongs in the middle)
- 1 package dry erase markers
- 1 ream of computer paper
- 1 ream of Cardstock paper
- Emergency pack to be turned in by end of first week of school

The following items need to be available to your student at all times throughout the school year. Usually by Christmas break supplies need to be re-evaluated and replenished.

- Four (4) highlighters – various colors
- 3 White-out tape, NO LIQUID WHITE OUT!
- 5-10 blue or black ballpoint pens, avoid gel pens
- 5-10 red ballpoint pens
- 1 pair of adult-sized scissors, marked with name
- One package thin-tipped markers (8-12 colors) or one package of multi-colored flair pens
- One package of colored pencils
- 1 pack of permanent markers (Sharpies); @ least ONE black fine-tipped
- Two (2) packages of 3-1/2 x 5" index cards – 100 each
- Post it notes/ Post it flags
- Zip style pencil case, clearly marked with student's name, to travel with student to EVERY CLASS!
- One ruler
- One package of graph paper
